

PROVIDER'S APPLICATION FOR PROGRAM APPROVAL

An Approved Program can be presented an unlimited number of times each year for a \$25 per year fee. Continuing education must contribute directly to the professional competency of the social worker and must be directly related to the skills and knowledge required to implement social work principles and methods.

Continuing education program content must relate to theories and concepts of human behavior and the social environment, social work knowledge and skills, social work research or practice evaluation, social work ethics, or cross disciplinary courses directly relevant to social work practice or specialty.

Non acceptable topics include, but are not limited to, those contrary to the code of ethics, as well as topics such as marketing, business, personal enrichment, time management, supervisory sessions, technology enhancement, staff orientation, agency or other meetings regarding procedural issues, CPR classes, etc.

The approved program provider must report the licensee's completion of continuing education programs to the Board within 30 days from the date of the program presentation. Failure to do so may result in the loss of approved program status.

When forwarding the completed application be sure to enclose the \$25.00 processing fee. Make checks payable to the North Dakota Board of Social Work Examiners.
